

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

The Twinning partners should ensure that any legislation (especially alignment of legislation with the *Union acquis*), organisational structures, procedures and job profiles developed in the framework of the Twinning project are developed in an **inclusive and evidence-based process**.

Policy and legislative proposals should be supported by at least **basic impact assessments** (regulatory, fiscal) and they should be consulted with both internal and external actors (**inter-ministerial and public consultations**), as required by the legislation in the Beneficiary country.

PAR mainstreaming concerns you, when...



.. a twinning project includes any of the following:

- 1. Development of sector policies (strategies, action plans)
- 2. Development of new legislation or amendments
- 3. Development of service delivery legislation (administrative procedures)
- 4. Setting up and/or supporting agencies or (semi) independent organisational structures
- 5. Training of civil servants
- 6. HRM related issues in a sector (e.g. preparation of procedure guidelines)
- 7. Development of IT systems and websites

Process of Twinning Fiche approval:

 Draft twinning Fiches should be always checked by the PAR desk in the EU DEL and/or PAR colleagues in the relevant ministries / NIPAC / PAO office



- Get well acquainted with the procedural law/policymaking requirements concerning impact assessments, inter-ministerial coordination, public consultations, standards for strategy development and ensure full respect to them in project activities.
- Liaise with ministries in charge of PAR, EU
 Delegations and ongoing PAR projects (SIGMA and other projects) to understand the administrative challenges and to promote the horizontal PAR efforts.
- If ever in doubt that the twinning project could risk contributing to 'silo' administration/fragmentation, engage the responsible PAR ministry colleagues and EU Delegations
